


## About the Creators

With over 15 years of professional experience, Olga specializes in children's book illustrations. Her husband, their two children, their dog, and the beautiful Spanish weather


inspire Olga to bring stories to life. One of Olga's greatest joys is seeing children's imaginations light up when they engage with her creations.
