Preparing your entry for the North Street Book Prize

Before I submit my entry to the North Street Book Prize, I have made sure that...

- I am submitting a full-length, self-published book. (Want to submit individual poems instead? See our [Tom Howard/Margaret Reid Poetry Contest](#) or the [Wergle Flomp Humor Poetry Contest](#). Individual stories or essays? Consider our [Tom Howard/John H. Reid Fiction & Essay Contest](#).)
- the book I am submitting is self-published and available to the public (it is not an unpublished manuscript nor has it been published by a selective press)
- my entry belongs to one of the following categories: Mainstream/Literary Fiction; Genre Fiction (e.g. romance, mystery, thriller, young adult, science fiction, fantasy, historical fiction, etc.); Creative Nonfiction & Memoir; Poetry; Children's Picture Book; Graphic Novel & Memoir; or Art Book
- my entry does not belong to any of the following categories: Self-Help/Self-Development; How-To; scholarly work intended for a specialized audience; Biography; books for older children (ages 8-12, also called Middle-Grade Fiction); political or religious tracts; Cookbooks
- my entry is written in English
- my entry is 200,000 words or fewer
- my entry is by a maximum of 2 authors (at least one of whom is living)
- my entry is not a translation of another author's work into English
- my entry is in .doc, .docx, .pdf, .odt, epub, or .mobi format (you may also submit a printed copy by mail)
- my entry uses a standard font that is easy to read (e.g. Times New Roman, Arial, or Verdana)

If we see a problem in your entry, Winning Writers will contact you to resolve it. If we can't resolve the problem, we'll refund your entry fee.
