Preparing your entry for the Tom Howard/Margaret Reid Poetry Contest

Before I submit my entry to the Tom Howard/Margaret Reid Poetry Contest, I have made sure that...

- I am submitting between one and three poems per entry
- each poem I submit is 250 lines or fewer (not counting the title or blank lines)
- my entry is written in English
- my entry is in .doc, .docx, .pdf, .odt, .rtf, or .txt format
- my entry uses a standard font that is easy to read, such as Times New Roman, Arial, or Verdana
- the documents I am submitting have no extra features enabled, such as comments or tracked changes
- the documents I am submitting **do not contain** identifying information, such as:
 - my name or initials
 - my email address
 - my mailing address
 - my phone number
 - links to my social media account or other websites with identifying information

If we see a problem in your entry, Winning Writers will contact you to resolve it. We will *not* silently disqualify your entry.
