Preparing your entry for the Tom Howard/John H. Reid Fiction & Essay Contest

Before I submit my entry to the Tom Howard/John H. Reid Fiction & Essay Contest, I have made sure that...

- I am submitting a short story or essay. (Want to submit poetry instead? Check out our [Tom Howard/Margaret Reid Poetry Contest](#) or the [Wergle Flomp Humor Poetry Contest](#). Full-length books and collections? Consider our [North Street Book Prize](#).)
- my entry has 6,000 words or fewer (excluding the title and any footnotes)
- my entry is written in English
- my entry is in .doc, .docx, .pdf, or .odt format
- my entry uses a standard font that is easy to read, such as Times New Roman, Arial, or Verdana
- the document I am submitting has no extra features enabled, such as comments or tracked changes
- my document does not include identifying information, such as:
 - my name or initials
 - my email address
 - my mailing address
 - my phone number
 - links to my social media account or other websites with identifying information

If we see a problem in your entry, Winning Writers will contact you to resolve it. We will *not* silently disqualify your entry.
