Preparing your entry for the Wergle Flomp Humor Poetry Contest

Before I submit my entry to the Wergle Flomp Humor Poetry Contest, I have made sure that...

- I am submitting a humor poem (Want to submit a serious poem instead? Try our [Tom Howard/Margaret Reid Poetry Contest](#))
- I am submitting only one poem
- my poem is written in English (or inspired gibberish)
- my poem has no more than 250 lines (you can exclude the title and all blank lines from your count)
- my poem is in .doc, .docx, .pdf, or .odt format, or I plan to type or paste the text of my poem into the entry field of the online submission form
- my poem does not include identifying information such as:
 - my name or initials
 - my email address
 - my mailing address
 - my phone number
 - links to my social media account or other websites with identifying information

All the contact information we need is collected on our online form and linked to your poem with a unique number. Want to know how anonymous judging works? See our video, [“How Anonymous Judging Works at Winning Writers”](#).

If we see a problem in your entry, Winning Writers will contact you to resolve it. We will *not* silently disqualify your entry.
